

## I understand and agree to the following....

### PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE

#### TARDIES

*Timeliness is held in high regard as it is everyone's responsibility to contribute to teaching and learning environments that are uninterrupted.*

**EMI – Excused missed instruction** (Medical per parent or excused by school staff)

**UMI – Unexcused missed instruction** (slept late, missed bus, late ride to school...)

- More than 10 minutes late to class = automatic lunch detention
- \*2 total UMI's / semester without consequence (*\*includes ALL classes*)
  - \*3 or 4 total tardies = **LUNCH DETENTION**
  - \*5 – 9 total tardies = **AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION**
  - \*10<sup>th</sup> tardy = **LOSS OF OFF CAMPUS**
- 1<sup>st</sup> period tardies will not lead to detentions, but missed instruction will negatively impact academic progress/ grades.
  - Excessive 1<sup>st</sup> period tardies will lead to negative behavioral consequences

#### DRESS CODE

*Students should dress appropriately for a professional learning environment.*

- Alternate clothing immediately provided if students violate dress code
- Detentions issued after 2 dress code violations / semester

#### TECHNOLOGY

**Class time** – personal devices used with teacher permission only.

**Passing time** – only 1 ear bud at a time as a safety rule to enable students to hear adult directives.

All technology violations result in immediate confiscation by the teacher.

| <b>1<sup>st</sup> Violation =</b> | device returned at end of class                         |
| <b>2<sup>nd</sup> Violation =</b> | student pick up from office at end of the day           |
| <b>3<sup>rd</sup> Violation =</b> | parent pick up from office (hours 7am – 3:30pm)         |
| <b>4<sup>th</sup> Violation =</b> | parent conference, **device banned for rest of semester |

\*\*If school issued laptop is confiscated, student will be issued a laptop as needed for specific classes.

#### INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

**Consequences** – based on course policies and procedures, may include, but not limited to:

- Removal from class for the period
- Lunch Detention
- Parent Contact
- After School Detention
- In-School-Suspension (ISS)
- Saturday School
- Out of School Suspension

## **CLOSED CAMPUS / LOSS OF PRIVILEGE**

**Starting 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter** – students NOT in good standing required to remain on campus at lunch below 2.0 GPA (NIAA Eligibility)

- 3 minor behaviors (dress code, technology, inappropriate behavior)
  - 1 Major Behavior (suspension)
  - 10 or more Total tardies
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## **LUNCH DETENTION**

Daily, 20 minutes, THEATER

NO Technology, NO Talking, NO sitting together

## **AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION**

Mon, Tues, Thurs, LEARNING CENTER, Rm 208, 2:20 – 3:20pm NO Technology, NO Talking, NO sitting together

## **SATURDAY SCHOOL**

Monthly, 9am – 12pm

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## **Some Behaviors Can Result In Immediate Expulsion / Permanent Removal From School**

- Possession of deadly weapon on campus
  - Selling of controlled or illegal substances on campus
  - Violence to staff or students
  - Persistent and pervasive bullying or harassment
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## **ATTENDANCE**

- 5 or more unexcused absences = Automatic Failure!!! (10 unexcused for 1<sup>st</sup> period) = *NRS 392.122*
- Excused Absences / Tardies = Medical, school events, legal appts
  - o Parents must call or send a note within 3 days of absence!

## **SCHOOL SAFETY**

- **EVACUATIONS During Passing Time** – Exit building immediately, meet with your 1<sup>st</sup> period teacher
  - o No 1<sup>st</sup> period class? Meet in front of school with Mrs. Brown (librarian)
- **SINGLE POINT ENTRY** – after 7:35am, all doors will be locked except front entrance
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> floor doors may be propped open during lunch only
- **OFF CAMPUS / NO SCHEDULED CLASS** – students must sign and follow *Off Campus* guidelines
  - o If staying on campus = must be in a location with a sign-in sheet (library, office)
  - o No loitering in classrooms or hallways
- **PERSONAL PROPERTY** – lockers should be used. Items should NOT be left in halls.
  - o Incline HS & WCSD are not responsible for lost items.
